\$1 per paycheck

provides an amplified phone and the necessary training to a hard of hearing client, This results in an improved quality of life and the promotion of equal opportunities for our hard of hearing population.

\$5 per paycheck

provides 10 hours of pre-employment training to a person with a disability. Having the ability to obtain job readiness skills allows for individuals with special needs to gain confidence and independence.

\$10 per paycheck

provides 50 age appropriate books to an early childhood education classroom. Access to comprehensive early education programs results in children being kindergarten ready by age 5.

\$40 per paycheck

provides for 20 therapy visits with a licensed mental health professional to a child suffering with anxiety or depression. Without access to treatment, children are more at risk of suicidal thoughts, have difficulty in school, and difficulty in relationships with others.

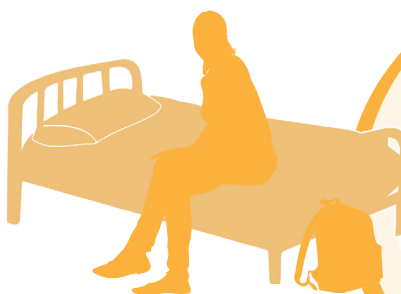

\$75 per paycheck provides for the time necessary to interview, screen and match 10 new mentors. Mentors encourage academic achievement, school success, emotional/social growth, healthy beliefs and clear standards of behavior to at risk youth.

provides 30 days of shelter, food, school supplies, clothing, transportation and medical attention to a homeless youth. These much needed services allow our at risk youth to become self-sufficient and productive citizens.
